## THE MYSTERIES OF JOY

These Mysteries contemplate the event of the coming of Jesus, the incarnation of the Christic Spirit and His Passage on Earth.

1. Let us contemplate the Annunciation of the Archangel Gabriel to Mary: We are before the “Yes” that opened the door to the Redemption of Humanity and all Life.

2. Let us contemplate the visit of Mary to Her cousin Elizabeth: We are before the Unity that is manifested in the fulfillment of Divine Work. As Mary and Elizabeth, may we be able to see the presence of God within our brothers and sisters.

3. Let us contemplate the Birth of Jesus: We are before the Love of God, who became fragile and small for the Salvation of each one of His children.

4. Let us contemplate the Presentation of the Child Jesus in the Temple: We are before the Grace of putting ourselves in the arms of Mary in order to consecrate our existence to God.

5. Let us contemplate the scene in which Jesus is found in the Temple: Despite our apparent smallness, may we fulfill the Will of God, following the example of His Son.

## THE MYSTERIES OF LIGHT

These Mysteries contemplate the public Life of Jesus, bringing Light to our world.

1. Let us contemplate the Baptism of Jesus: Let us allow the Water of Life to wash us and consecrate us for a new cycle in which, permeated by the Holy Spirit, we may fulfill the Will of God.

2. Let us contemplate the miracle of Jesus during the Wedding at Cana: May we acknowledge the power of the intercession of Mary who, together with Her Son, transforms all things.

3. Let us contemplate Jesus announcing the Kingdom of God: By His Word, we were healed, rescued and redeemed and, in His promises, may our faith be established.

4. Let us contemplate the Transfiguration of Jesus: We are before the revelation of a sublime reality that transcends matter. Let us aspire to find Truth.

5. Let us contemplate the institution of the Eucharist: We are before the greatest act of Love of all Creation, when God surrendered Himself and became small within the bread and the wine, to be able to live within His children.

## THE MYSTERIES OF SORROW

These Mysteries contemplate the absolute donation of Jesus in the name of Salvation for all humanity.

1. Let us contemplate Jesus in the Garden of Olives: Love conquers fear and agony within the heart of Christ, who said “Yes” to God for our salvation.

2. Let us contemplate the Flagellation of Jesus: We are before the constant overcoming in Love, the renewal that Christ teaches us while receiving each Wound. His “Yes” is unalterable.

3. Let us contemplate the Crowning of Thorns: Here God teaches us that there is only one Kingdom, which is in the Heavens, and one only King: The One Who reigns through surrender and builds His reign through sacrifice and humility.

4. Let us contemplate Jesus carrying the Cross: May we learn to be grateful to He who paid our sins and laid them upon Himself, in the form of wood, inspiring us to do everything for Love.

5. Let us contemplate the Crucifixion and Death of Christ: The triumph of Christ that was hidden on the Cross, when Mercy and Love overcame darkness and, seemingly losing everything, God conquered our lives for Himself.

## THE MYSTERIES OF GLORY

These Mysteries contemplate the Glorification: the Eternal Life of Jesus and Mary in the Kingdom of Heaven.

1. Let us contemplate the Resurrection of Jesus: Christ revealed that Love conquers even what is most real to us: death. He reveals to us the true Life.

2. Let us contemplate the Ascension of Jesus and the Promise of His Return, and the Revelation and Manifestation of His Kingdom on Earth: May we prepare His path and, with Love, may we wait for His arrival, which could be now.

3. Let us contemplate the coming of the Holy Spirit: The manifestation of the Spirit of God that awakened the human heart to express what it truly is: Likeness with the Creator.

4. Let us contemplate the Assumption of Mary: The revelation of the Purity of Mary that showed us the path to reach the Heavens.

5. Let us contemplate the Coronation of Mary: Just as God, as Christ, as the Angels and the Archangels, we proclaim Her as our Mother and Lady, Our Queen, the One who takes us by the hand to the Heart of Her Son.
